Rules for organizing and conduct the Republic Junior Olympics

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1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. The Republican Junior Olympics among organizations of secondary vocational and professional education (hereinafter referred to as the RJ Olympics) are conducted by the Kurmangazy Kazakh National Conservatory (hereinafter referred to as the Conservatory) in order to ensure the quality of training for specialists in the field of musical art and to develop the creative abilities of children and youth.

2. The present Provision is developed based on the order of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan "On the Approval of the List of Republican and International Olympics and Competitions of Scientific Projects (Scientific Competitions) in General Education Subjects, Performers Competitions, Competitions of Professional Mastery and Sports Competitions" (dated December 7, 2011, No. 514) and the Charter of the Conservatory (dated September 12, 2022, No. 53).

2. THE GOALS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE OLYMPICS

3. The Republican Junior Olympics are held to select and support the most talented and gifted students of specialized music schools and colleges, develop their professional skills to support and preserve the best traditions and achievements of musical culture and performing arts of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

4. The main task of the Republican Junior Olympics is the further improvement and development of professional musical education in the Republic of Kazakhstan, stimulating the creative activities of educators in specialized music schools and colleges, unlocking the professional and personal potential of participants, their creative abilities, and creating conditions for self-realization and self-assertion.

3. CONDITIONS AND TIMELINES FOR THE OLYMPICS

5. Republican Junior Olympics Implemented in offline format in base Kurmangazy Kazakh National Conservatory.

6. Students of graduating (10-12) classes of specialized music schools and students of the 3rd-4th courses of music colleges are eligible to participate in the Olympics.

7. The Republic Junior Olympics is conducted in the following specialties and nominations:

- Composition;
- Music Theory;
- Piano;
- String instruments in the nominations: "Violin", "Viola", "Cello", "Double Bass", "Classical Guitar";
- Woodwind and Percussion instruments in the nominations: "Woodwind Instruments", "Brass Instruments", "Percussion Instruments";
- Conducting in the nomination: "Choral Conducting";

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- Academic Singing in the nominations: “Male Voices”, “Female Voices”;
- Folk Instruments in the nominations: “Dombra”, “Three-stringed Instruments”, “Folk Instruments”, “Prima Kobyz”, “Alt Kobyz and Bass Kobyz”, “Bayan, Accordion”;
- Traditional Singing in the nominations: “Folk Singing”, “Zhyrshylar”;
- The Republic Junior Olympics is held annually by the Conservatory in March-April.

8. Information about each nomination (Provisions, requirements, application form, event dates) is located on the conservatory's website under the section “Olympics”.

9. Chairman and jury composition Republican Junior Olympics formed from representatives of the teaching staff Conservatory and leading specialists from musical institutions of Republic of Kazakhstan in an odd number;

10. At the voting, the Chairman has 2 votes, while the commission members have 1 vote each.

11. Participants who have won prize places are awarded the title of laureate of the Junior Olympics and receive diplomas of I, II, and III degrees;

12. The deadline for submitting applications to participate in the Republic Junior Olympics expires 2 weeks before the start of the competition in a specific nomination.

13. Participants who have passed the internal selection process at their educational institutions are eligible to participate in the Republic Junior Olympics. Laureates of previous years' I prizes are not allowed to participate in the Olympics.

4. RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF ORGANIZERS

14. To organize and conduct the Republic Junior Olympics, the composition of the organizing committee, determining the general procedure for conducting the Olympics, is approved by the order of the Rector of the Conservatory;

15. The list of jury members and responsible person for each nomination is determined by the organizational committee of the Republic Junior Olympics and approved by the order of the Rector.

16. The procedure for conducting the Republic Junior Olympics for each nomination is organized by the respective department of the Conservatory;

17. The Organizing Committee coordinates the work of specialized departments in sending informational emails to potential participants of the Republic Junior Olympics, and makes suggestions regarding the procedure for conducting and awarding.

18. The specialized departments have the right to reject applications if the indicated program does not meet the requirements for participants of the Republic Junior Olympics.

19. The Organizing Committee arranges photo and video shooting, the materials of which belong to the Conservatory, and participants automatically give their consent for their use on the Conservatory's resources by submitting their application.

5. RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF PARTICIPANTS.

20. Participants have the right to receive information about the timing and conditions of the Republic Junior Olympics.

21. Participants Republic Junior Olympics required to adhere to these Provisions and carry out all actions related to participation in the Olympics.

6. SUMMING UP THE RESULTS, AWARDING THE PARTICIPANTS

22. The results of the Republic Junior Olympics are summarized by the jury for each specialty, consisting of the chairman and commission members approved by the order of the Conservatory's Rector;

- Winners of the Olympics are awarded 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places:
- 1st place – one winner's diploma;
- 2nd place – two winner's diplomas;
- 3rd place – three winner's diplomas.

23. Additional rewards may be given to participants for the best performance in various categories established by the specialized department (no more than 2 for each nomination).

24. Jury have rights: not all prize places and diplomas are awarded; diplomas are awarded for the best performance

25. The decisions of the jury for each specialty are final and not subject to revision.

7. FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

26. Participation of students from secondary vocational and professional education institutions in the Republic Junior Olympics is free of charge.

8. PROCEDURE FOR MAKING CHANGES

27. Suggestions for changes to these Provisions discussion in the meeting of the Academic Council, decisions are made or revoked by a majority vote (not less than 2/3 of the votes of the members of the Academic Council present at the meeting).

28. Changes to the Provisions are made only by the decision of the Academic Council of the Conservatory based on official letters from the Head of the Educational and Methodological department, approved by the Vice-Rector for Academic and Educational and Methodological Work.

29. Changes to the Provisions are made in accordance with the requirements The QUALITY MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT with a mandatory note in the "Change Registration Sheet".

30. Notifications about changes in procedure links all to departments and responsible structural units of the Conservatory.

31. The original of the Provisions is kept in the Documentation Support Department. The Educational and Methodological Department carries out the distribution of copies of the procedure to the structural units of the Conservatory.

9. FINAL PROVISIONS

32. This Provision, as well as changes and additions made to it, are approved by the Rector of the Conservatory and take effect after their approval.

33. The item of this Provision are mandatory and may be changed or supplemented in connection with changes in regulatory documents, the emergence of new additional expenses not covered by this document.

34. Other matters arising from the implementation of the provisions of this Provision are resolved in accordance with the Charter of the Conservatory or the current legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan.
